Total Tourists From Canada – 1,739.1 thousand

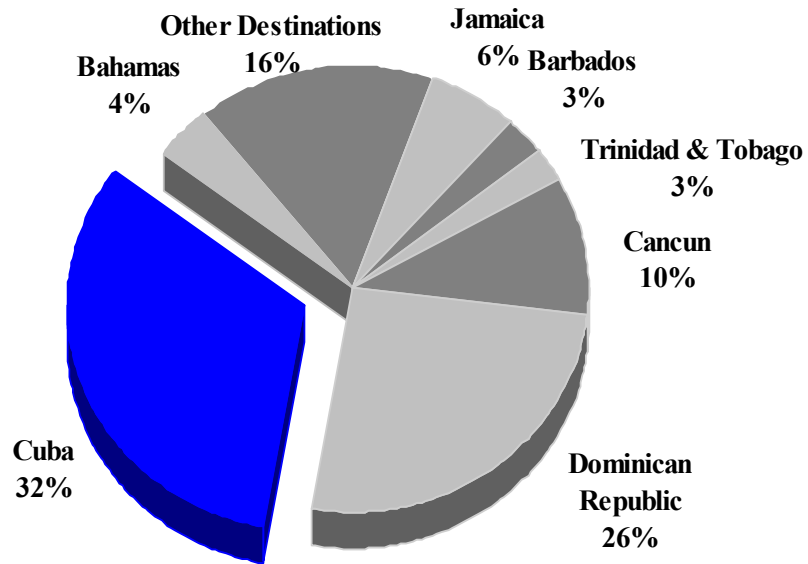

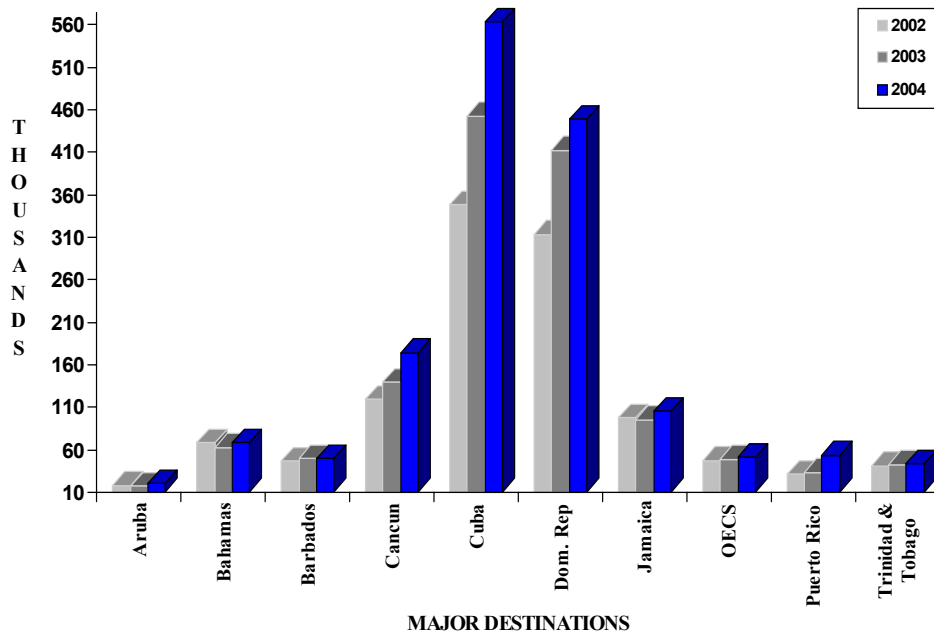
