

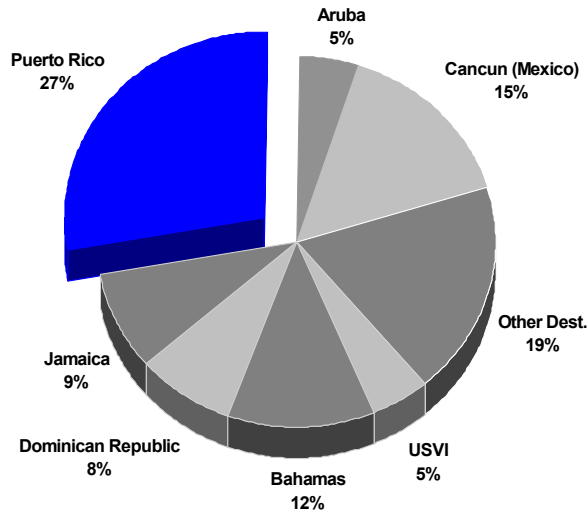

## TOURIST ARRIVALS 2002-2004

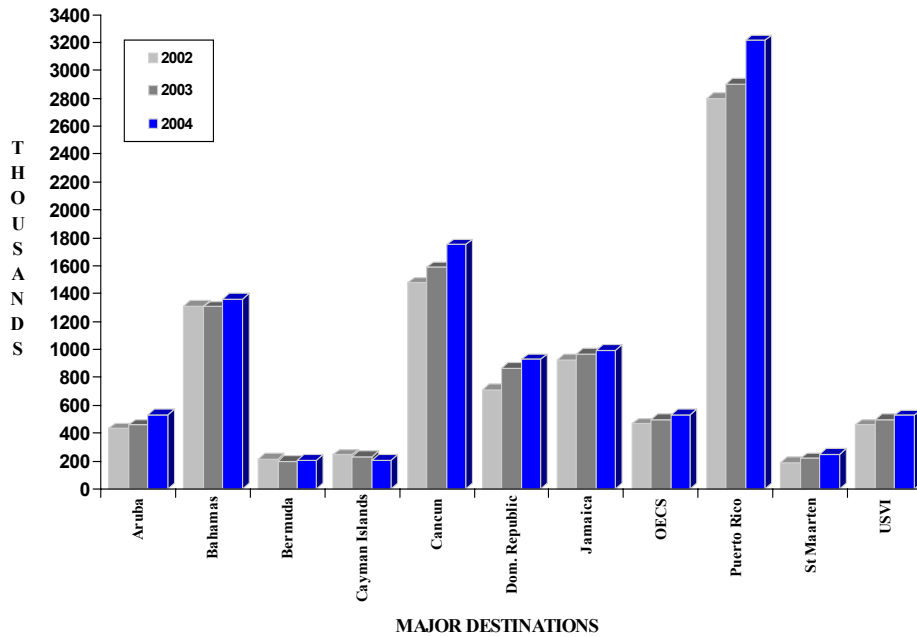


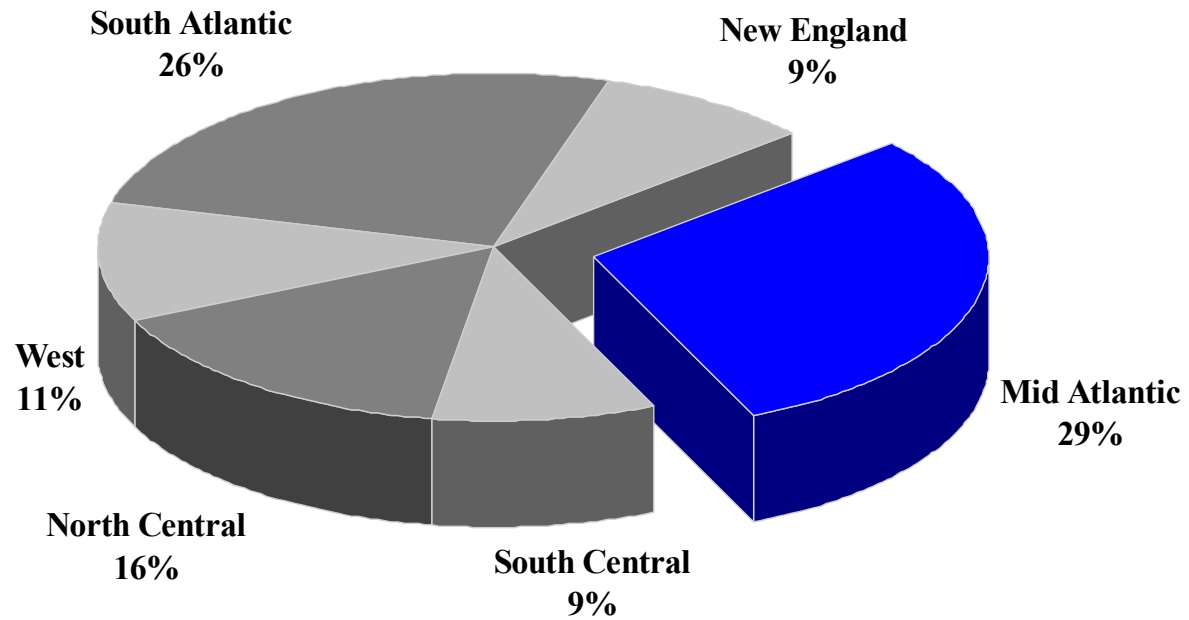

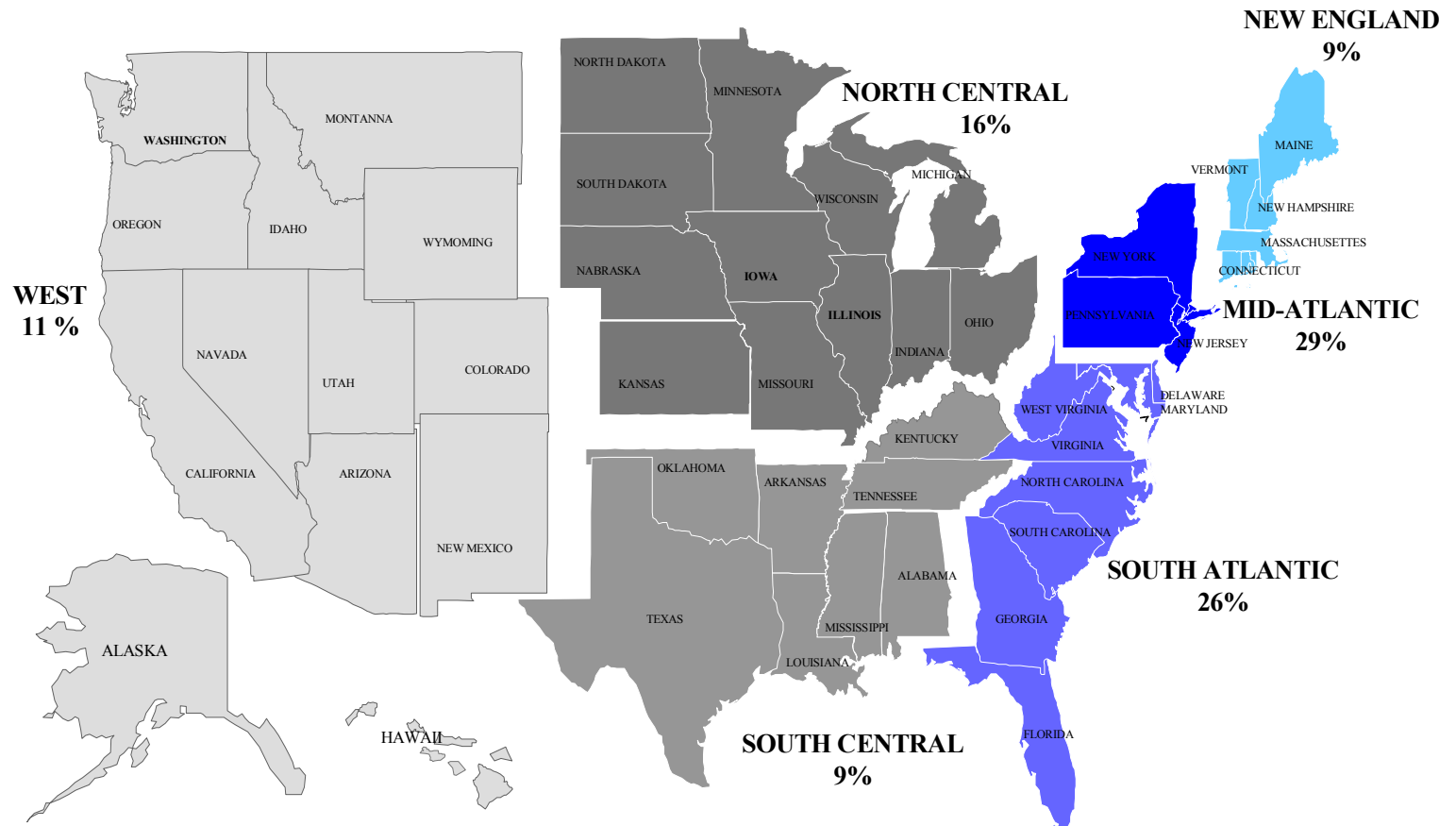
