### Results from Antigua Tourism Learning System Workshop

Regional tourism educators supported the Tourism Learning System as a planning framework and have recommended that the CTHRC:

1. Communicate regularly as the key **Caribbean Tourism HRD Information Broker** (Serve as a “Tourism HRD Observatory”) **VERY HIGH**
2. Promote and Coordinate **Regional Curriculum Development Projects** –HIGH
  - i. Individual Course/Topic Development  
e.g. Service Quality; Information Technology; Environmental Awareness
  - ii. Full Program Core Curriculum Development  
e.g. Hospitality Management Diploma Program
3. Develop and Implement **Professional Development** Activities for Tourism Educators **HIGH**
  - Annual Educators’ Forum
  - Workshops on Curriculum Development Approaches (at all levels)
  - Industry site visits and presentations by industry professionals
4. Coordinate a Regional Approach to **Tourism Career Awareness** Programs and Resource Development and Activity **MEDIUM -- HIGH**
5. Encourage Coordination and Communication of **Articulation & Accreditation** activity by appropriate agencies (ACTI etc.) **HIGH**
6. Develop, promote and communicate opportunities for more regional **Faculty Exchanges and Student Internships** **MEDIUM**
7. Encourage Development of regional **Credential Recognition and Prior Learning Assessment** guidelines for hospitality and tourism programs **MEDIUM**
